

Our Commitment to Privacy: ReviewInc Privacy Policy

Welcome to ReviewInc.com. This policy outlines our privacy practices and website terms of use.

By accessing, viewing or using any of our services, you acknowledge that you have read, understand, and agree to be bound by and subject to this Privacy Policy and [Terms of Use](#) unless separate terms are offered by you in writing and accepted in writing by ReviewInc. If you do not agree to all the terms and conditions of this agreement, then you may not access the website or use any services.

This Privacy Policy explains the data collection and use practices of ReviewInc through all Services provided by ReviewInc. This Privacy Policy does not include the Privacy Policies of any third-party review sites which may be used, which may have their own policies which will apply.

ReviewInc may modify this policy at any time either by providing notification on our home page. For your information this policy was last updated on August 1, 2024.

Data We Collect and How We Use It

We do not collect personal information from this website (www.reviewinc.com) except to the extent you voluntarily provide it as part of an inquiry or other contact to this site. This information is used only as necessary to respond to such inquiry. Personal information collected by ReviewInc is generally used for the purpose for which it is collected or as otherwise set forth in this Privacy Policy.

We also collect information using cookies and log files that may collect your information such as internet protocol (IP) addresses, browser type, internet service provider (ISP), referring/exit pages, Services type, date/time stamp, and the number of clicks. This information is used to analyze trends, administer the site, track user's movement, and keystrokes within the site, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use. IP addresses, etc. are not linked to personally identifiable information. The log files are used by utility tracking software to analyze user movement. Users are responsible for any third-party information obtained, published or shared through our Site and confirm they have the appropriate authority to share such personal information.

We also collect personal information through our Services and platform on behalf of our clients. This includes various types of submissions, including but not limited to through reviews and forms. In addition, we collect some very limited geolocational data. All such collection is voluntary and only used for the purpose of providing those services to the client in question.

Any data collected is processed and stored in the United States.

Information Retention

ReviewInc will retain personal information, Client and business information for as long as it is needed to provide services requested; to communicate with you about a request you have made; to comply with our legal and regulatory obligations, to demonstrate compliance, and to enforce ReviewInc's rights and agreements. All geolocational data is retained for no more than 24 hours.

We Do Not Share Your Personal Information

We do not share personal information with third parties unless it is necessary to comply with the law, in response to a good faith belief it is necessary to protect our rights or property or the rights of third parties, or to any successor or purchaser in a merger, acquisition, liquidation, dissolution or sale of assets.

No mobile information will be shared with third parties/affiliates for marketing/promotional purposes. All other categories exclude text messaging originator opt-in data and consent; this information will not be shared with any third parties.

Our service providers process personal information on our behalf in order to assist with providing and improving the Services, customer service, and our own marketing and sales.

We do not sell your personal information.

Data Security

We take reasonable administrative, physical and electronic measures designed to safeguard and protect your information from unauthorized access or disclosure. This includes utilizing software which encrypts the personal information you input, and storing your information in encrypted form behind a firewall designed to block access from outside our network. However, no security or encryption method can be guaranteed to protect information from hackers or human error

California Disclosures

Shine the Light Disclosures: Civil Code Section 1798.83 permits you to request information regarding the disclosure of your personal information to third parties for the third parties' direct marketing purposes. We do not share your information for this purpose.

Do Not Track Disclosures: Business and Professions Code Sections 22575(b) requires websites to disclose their practices with respect to the use of tracking technology by third parties and whether the site honors “web browser” do not track signals. No third parties are able to collect personally identifiable information from this website. As a result, at this time, ReviewInc. does not respond to Do Not Track browser settings or signals.

European Union/United Kingdom Privacy Rights

If you are located in the European Union (“EU”)/United Kingdom (“UK”), you have rights under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR).

- The right to access. You have the right to request copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service, although we will avoid that if we can.
- The right to rectification. You have the right to request that we correct any information you believe is inaccurate, and/or to complete information you believe is incomplete.
- The right to erasure. You have the right to request that we erase your personal data, unless certain conditions or exemptions apply.
- The right to restrict processing. You have the right to request that we restrict the processing of your personal data, unless certain conditions or exemptions apply.
- The right to object to processing. You have the right to object to our processing of your personal data, unless certain conditions or exemptions apply.
- The right to data portability. You have the right to request that we transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, unless certain conditions or exemptions apply.

Where we process the data of an individual subject to GDPR (or its UK equivalent), it does so on a number of legal bases. Depending on the type of information processed, our basis for processing can include: (1) your consent; (2) where necessary to perform a contract with you such as the sale of tea; (3) where necessary for legal compliance purposes; (4) where such processing is necessary to protect the vital interests of you or another person; (5) where the processing is necessary to carry out a task of public interest; and (6) where the legitimate interests of ReviewInc or a third party allow it.

The vast majority of the processing done by us is done for the purpose of providing the Services, by the consent of Users, and/or to fulfill legal obligations.

You have the right to complain to your local data protection authority if you are unhappy with our privacy practices.

Children

ReviewInc's website and services are not directed or targeted towards children. ReviewInc does not have any knowledge of specific users, 16 years old or under, making use of ReviewInc's website and/or services.
